

**MINUTES
CITY OF CEDAR HILL
BEAUTIFICATION AND ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY BOARD MEETING
AUGUST 19, 2021**

The Beautification and Environmental Sustainability Board met on Thursday, August 19, 2021, at 6:00 p.m. in the CHISD Training Room located at the Cedar Hill Government Center. I. Call meeting to order

Hart called the meeting to order at 6:04 pm.

II. Approve minutes of July 15, 2021

III. Citizen's Forum

V. Green Awards

VI. BES Board Programs

The Board brainstormed on potential new programs.

- Develop a tree program to fill in “dead spots.” Board needs to consider maintenance.
- Develop a trails lighting project possibly with solar.
- Develop a composting project.
- Develop a creek auditing program for litter and debris. Board needs to consider private property rights.
- Develop a Joe Pool Lake water quality testing program possibly in partnership with TCC.
- Construct an entry monument sign along FM 1382.
- Develop community gardens specifically with flower beds. Further landscape medians near traffic lights.
- Enhance the birding program through partnerships with the Audubon and Cedar Ridge Preserve. Sponsor cleanups. Sponsor benches.
- Create QR code stickers for recycling bins for Know-What-To-Throw.

VII. Environmental Manager’s Report

Vu updated the Board on current City activities.

VIII. Adjourn

Hart made a motion to adjourn. Shaw seconded the motion. The motion was approved unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 7:32 pm.
