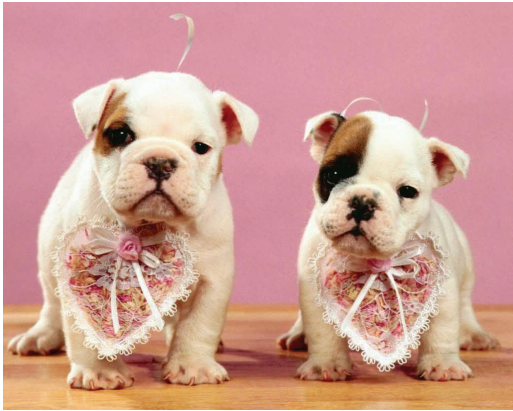
Special Pets
