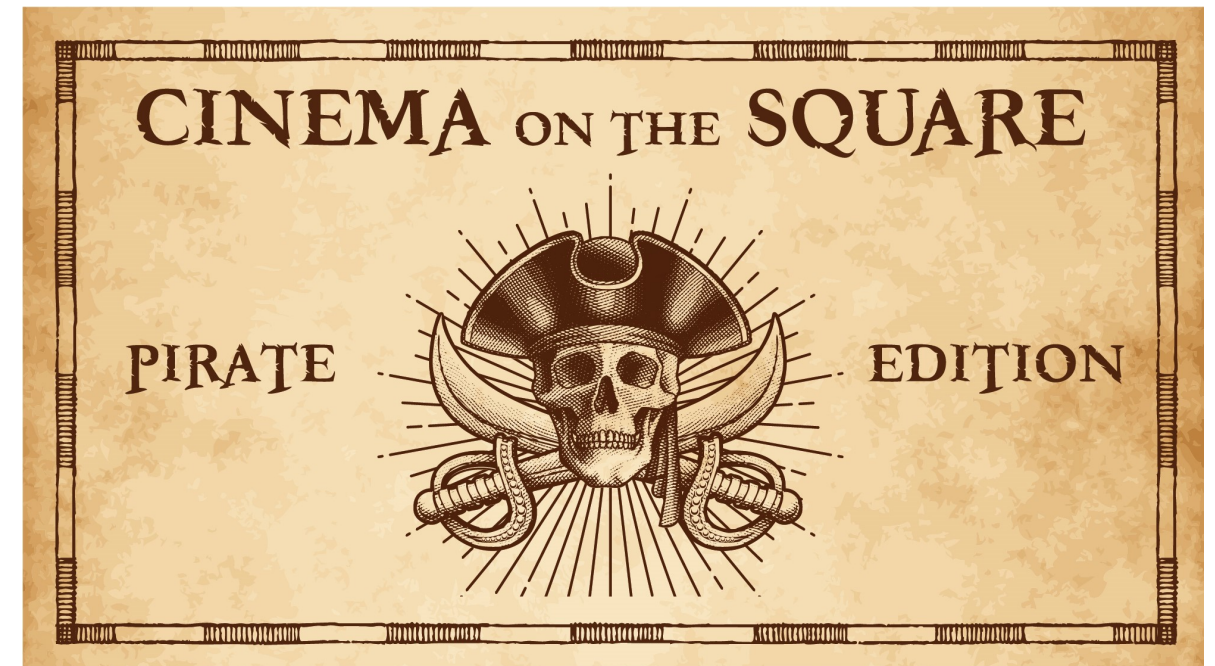
**Saturday, December 2, 2 pm — Holiday Make It Fair:** : A family-friendly event of invention, creativity, and celebration of the Maker movement.
