Storytime Sessions for Children:

Babies- Mondays, 10:30 am. For ages 0-2. This storytime class helps develop motor, sensory, and social skills through songs, movement, and rhyme while promoting pre-literacy skills and a love of books. Siblings under 5 years old may also attend as well. The Family Place Library Parent Playgroup will combine with storytime on January 28, February 4, 11, 18, and 25. These sessions will incorporate our stories, songs, and fingerplays with playtime for children ages 0-3 and their parents/caregivers. Community resource professionals will be in attendance with information and resources that help parents understand their role as their child's first teacher.
