Significant Investigation

On 2/24/2022, Cedar Hill Officers responded to the 1500 Blk of S Clark Rd in reference to a stabbing with injuries. The victim said he had been stabbed in the neck.

Officers located the victim's car unoccupied and after a brief search located the victim nearby. The victim was seriously injured and quickly transported to the hospital. At the time of this incident, there was no suspect information.

In the following days, Detectives were able to interview the victim and obtain more information about the incident. With additional investigation, Detectives were able to develop a suspect.

A warrant for arrest was issued for the suspect, who was taken into custody on 3/2/2022 without incident.
