I. Call Meeting to Order

Bertha called the meeting to order at 6:09PM.

II. Invocation

Bertha gave the invocation.

III. Citizens Forum

No one spoke.

IV. Approve May 2023 regular meeting minutes

Jackie made a motion to approve the May minutes, seconded by Josh. Motion passed unanimously.

V. Treasurer's Report

Jackie gave an update on the April 2023 financial reports. Bertha added that Cedar Crest PID funds should not be invested by the City of Cedar Hill unless agreed upon by the board.

VI. Provide Project Updates on the following:

a. Ornamental stop signs and poles

The board reviewed previous quotes and will contact a new representative from Brandon Industries since the previous representative stopped responding. The board agreed that they would like Public Works to go ahead and replace the 30 identified stop signs that are faded. Tia will contact Public Works to get this started and request references from Onsite Industries as well as find out what vendors other builders have used.

b. Review quotes for additional lighting for newly planted trees at Tar Rd. and Mt. Lebanon

The board reviewed various quotes from LandWorks, Bob Owens Electric, and J&K Electric. Before making a decision, the board agreed that they would need further



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information regarding conduit versus cable and if damaged sod will be replaced after installation.

c. Status on re-painting electrical boxes

Bertha will follow up with Gabby from Oncor and recommended to keep this item on the next agenda for updates.

d. Cluster mailbox replacement or refurbish

Jackie has made contact with the Cedar Hill Post Office and awaiting answers on if the mailboxes can be refurbished and what permissions are required to do so.

e. Discuss and review quotes for tree trimming

The board reviewed quotes from Big Bird Tree Service, Top Line Tree Care, and LandWorks. The board agreed to move forward with Big Bird Tree Service for \$2,800 that will include pruning and fertilization for 8 trees. After that is completed, the board agreed the LandWorks may do pesticide treatment for \$340 after insuring that there will not be any chemical reactions from Big Bird's fertilization.
