Please be aware that barking dogs or loose animals may be in violation of City Ordinance 2016-597. We encourage all pet owners to ensure their animals are properly contained and controlled to avoid potential issues.

DID YOU KNOW?

Some of the lots in Cedar Crest are actually larger than they might appear. This means that the area behind your fence might actually be part of your property, and you could be responsible for maintaining it. It might be a good idea to check your property lines to ensure you're aware of the full extent of your land.

Why is this important?

If you find that your property extends further than your fence, please be aware that this could be a utility easement. Keeping easements clear helps ensure that utility services are delivered efficiently. If access is blocked or compromised, it can lead to delays in service or issues with utility performance.

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PARKING DO'S

Do Use Designated Spaces: Parking in your driveway helps clear the street for easy access in the event of an emergency.

Do Check The Day: On Thursdays trash and recycling are collected. Every 3rd Monday is bulk/brush service. Please do not block carts or bulk/brush piles.

Do Lock Your Vehicle: For safety and security, always lock your car when leaving it.

Do Leave Adequate Space: Make sure there's enough room for other vehicles and pedestrians to move around your parked car.

PARKING DON'TS

Don't Block Driveways: Avoid parking in front of driveways, entrances, or fire hydrants.

Don't Double Park: Avoid parking in a manner that blocks other vehicles or creates an obstruction.

Don't Park on Lawns or Sidewalks: Keep your vehicle off grass, sidewalks, and other non-parking areas.

Don't Leave Valuables in Sight: For safety reasons, avoid leaving valuables visible inside your car.

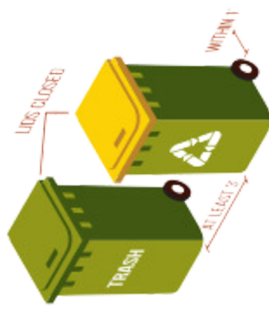
CART PLACEMENT INSTRUCTIONS

- Place carts within one foot from the curb—or fence, if in an alley—with the handles facing the home or fence.
- Give carts plenty of space. The automated control arms need at least three feet of space on all sides of your carts in order to pick them up. Keep trash and recycling carts at least three feet apart and at least five feet from cars, mail boxes, gas meters, and other nearby objects.
- Trash must be contained. Place your trash in securely tied plastic bags. All bags must fit inside the cart with the lid closed. Any trash left on top of or beside the cart will not be collected.
- Set it out by 7 a.m. on your collection day.
