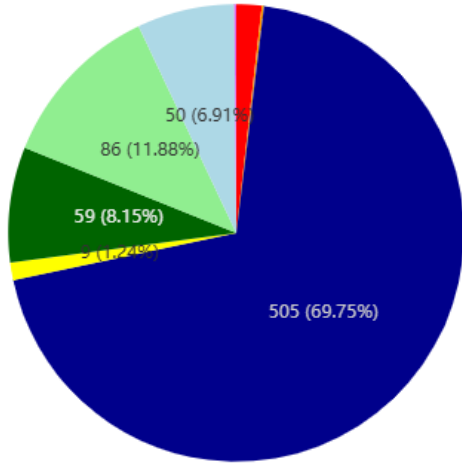
### *Around the Neighborhood*
