

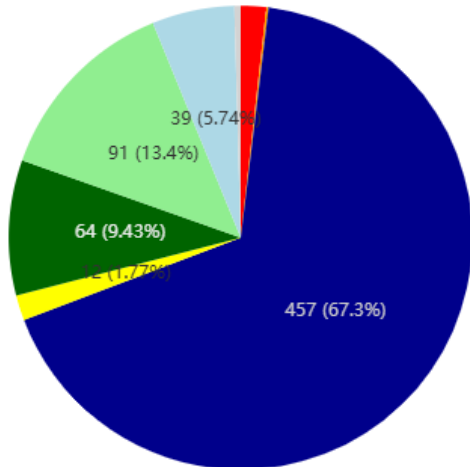

Around The Community

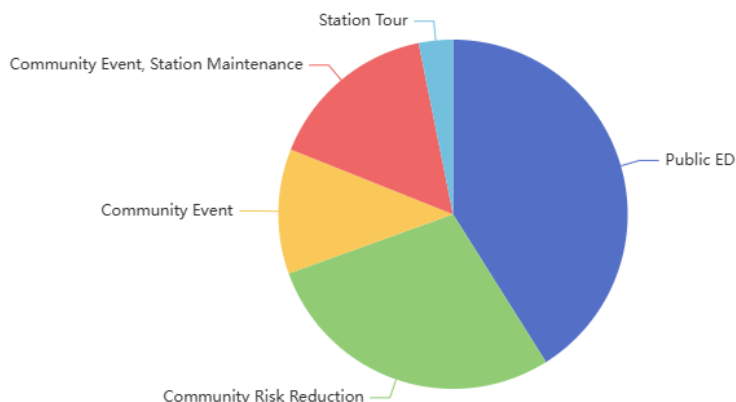

Fire Hydrants Inspected 101

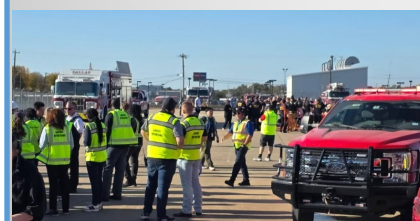

Several Cedar Hill Firefighters took the Ambus to participate in a regional mass casualty drill. The drill was conducted in partnership with Dallas Fire Rescue, McKinney Fire Department, Texas Division of Emergency Management, Parkland Hospital, and others at Love Field. The exercise tested the response to a large-scale, mass casualty incident requiring quick coordination between a wide array of assets from various departments, from the start of the incident, to transfer of care to the hospital. The Ambus, a regional Emergency Medical Task Force asset, is capable of transporting many lower-acuity patients at once, saving ambulances for more critical patients. You may typically see this unit sent to assist with evacuations preceding hurricanes or other severe weather, for example.
